I would like to invite you and your students to the ENVIREE project summer school, which is organised by AGH (University of Science and Technology) in Krakow, Poland, 27-28 April 2017.

The ENVIREE project, funded from ERA – MIN programme, aims at recovery of REE (rare earths elements) from secondary sources such as tailings and mining waste.

The main target of this Summer School are MSc and PhD students but also industry, researchers, policy makers, environmental organizations, wanting to get familiar with sustainable use of resources, especially recovery of Rare Earths from secondary sources.

The summer school topics comprise environmental impact of REE recovery, including Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) and also land reclamations techniques for residues after beneficiation of the secondary sources of REE.

No fees will be charged for registration and attendance. Certification of presence will be given to registered participants. Lunch and coffee breaks will be provided by organizers. Accommodation for students will be provided in a student hostel at AGH campus. Participants are responsible for making their own travel arrangements.
